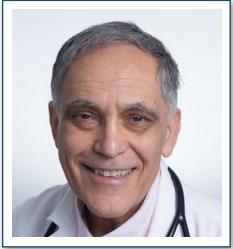
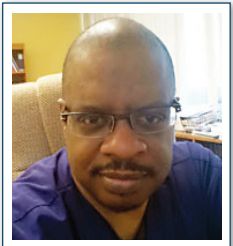


## About the Pulmonary Team:
